Despite withdrawal of the U.S. and other national entries from Brazil's São Paulo Bienal, the British team will carry on, reports the Sunday Times of London, "How can the regime be repressive to modern art if it is holding the Bienal?" it quotes sculptor Anthony Caro as saying. And color painter John Hoyland, his teammate, notes, "I don't want to confuse art with politics."...
